Cobra Gold 2011

Pattaya, Thailand

Following the completion of the 2011 Cobra Gold Exercise in Thailand, Navy League Siam wanted to ensure that the sailors and marines were able to enjoy some well-deserved liberty in Pattaya and learn more about the unique culture of the region. The ships moored at the Laemchabang Port just north of Pattaya on February 21st, with USS STOCKDALE (DDG-106) arriving first. Navy League Siam was delighted to present the crew with SIM cards, generously donated by True Corporation, so that the sailors could use cell phones while in Thailand at a cost of approximately \$.03/minute.

At 0800 on February 21st, the USS ESSEX (LHD-2) arrived at Laemchabang, and Navy League Siam President, Mr. Peter Thorand, was honored to join the port brief and present the crew with free SIM cards and helpful maps of landmarks and sites in Pattaya. The USS DENVER (LPD-9) moored at 1300 hours, followed by the USS GERMANTOWN (LSD-42) at 1500. There were some troubles with the pier services that unfortunately delayed the GERMANTOWN for several hours. However, following the wait, the sailors were presented with twenty-dollar vouchers to the Marriott Resort & Spa in Pattaya, which were very much appreciated by our visiting military personnel.

Navy League Siam was delighted to get involved with three Community Relations (COMRELS) activities to include:

- Assisting the USS ESSEX partake in sporting and teaching activities at the Baan Nohong Charg Ngaw School on February 22nd
